Please mail your offer in a sealed envelope marked "Quotation Enclosed (19HA7020Q0021)" to GSO Procurement, American Embassy, Tabarre 41 on or before 14:00 hours September 22, 2020. Electronic offers will be accepted and no quotation will be accepted after this time.

Complete the OFFER portion of the Standard Form 18, including all blank spaces, and have the form signed by an authorized representative of your company, or the proposal may be considered unacceptable and may be rejected.

In order for a quotation to be considered, you must also complete and submit the following:

1. Section B and Attachment 2: Quotation Breakdown by Divisions.
2. Section K, Representations and Certifications;
3. Bar Chart illustrating sequence of work to be performed;
4. Additional information as required in Section L.
5. The successful offeror (s) will be required to have a DUNS number, an N-CAGE number and be registered in SAM.

The U.S. Government intends to award a contract/purchase order to the responsible company submitting an acceptable quotation at the lowest price. We intend to award a contract/purchase order based on initial quotations, without holding discussions, although we may hold discussions with companies in the competitive range if there is a need to do so.
